ENLACE seeks to be recognized as a leader in involving communities in the legislative process on issues relating to educational reform. As a collaborative we influence decisions concerning important issues by working with elected officials in our communities, our state capital and Washington, D.C.

How are legislative issues and priorities identified?

Our goal is a policy agenda which reflects the issues, concerns and priorities of ENLACE stakeholders, including students, families, and other community members in promoting educational equity for all students and to improve academic performance throughout the P-20 pathway in New Mexico. Defining policy issues and priorities is an evolving process which began in 2001; annual community forums allow us to update and polish our policy agenda.

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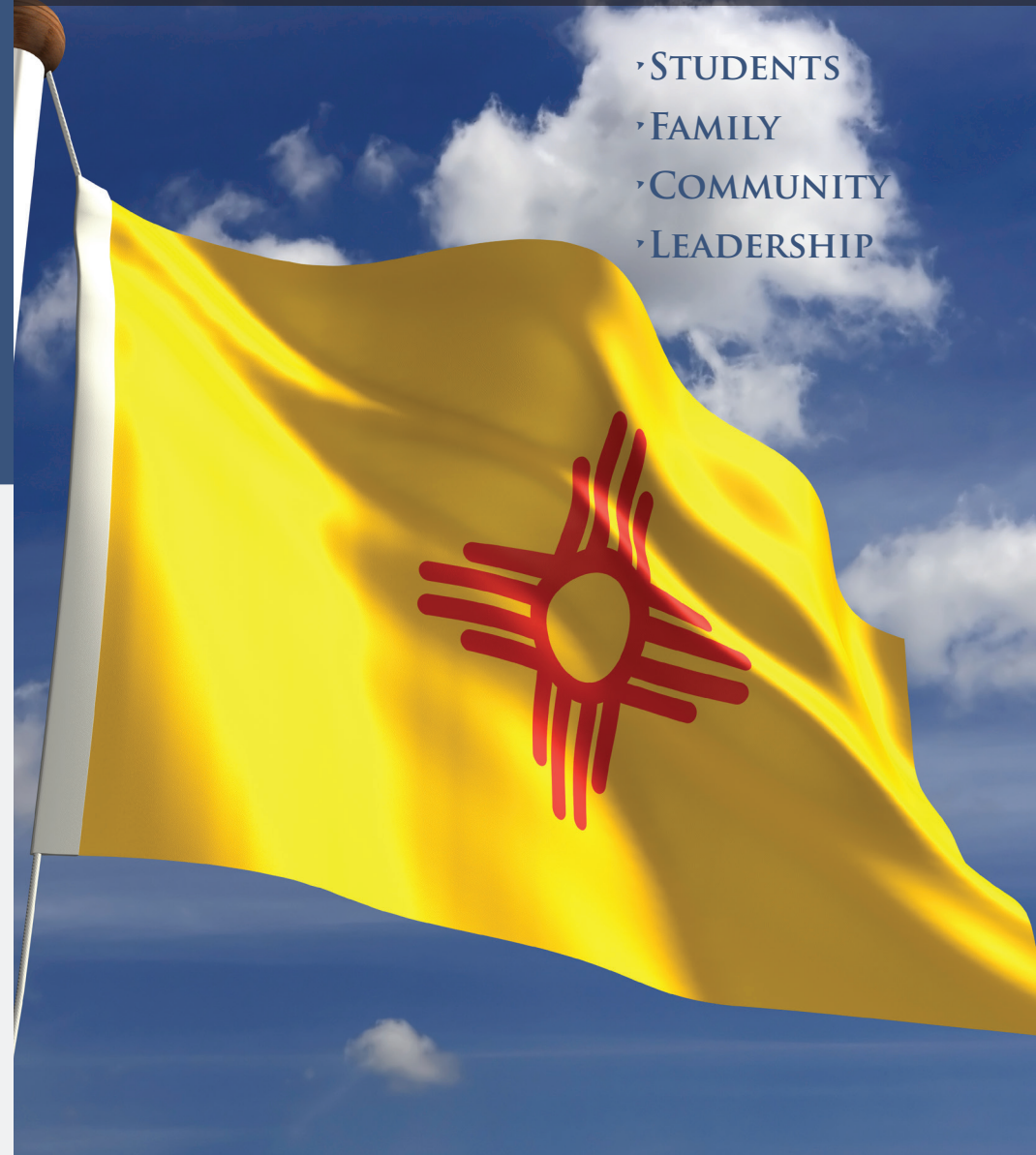
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2019 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES
